Thank you for your request dated 31st August, 2009, received by us on 23rd September, 2009. Your original request was sent to the Lands & Survey Department and subsequently channelled to this Authority. I am please to inform you that your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Law.

In your request you were trying to obtain information in regards to rented office space as detailed below:

- 1) A comprehensive list of every current government entity/authority/department unit/portfolio/ministries that is currently renting its office space. I am requesting a record/s that contain/s following information.
 - a. The location that is being rented
 - b. Square footage of the space being rented
 - c. The cost per square foot / month of the space being rented
 - d. Date of expiration for the lease agreement

The Port Authority of the Cayman Islands does not currently occupy any rented office space. Therefore, no records exist which contain the details of your request.

Should this final decision not satisfy you, you are entitled to request an Internal Review by this Public Authority for a review of this matter. The review is a full and new examination of the matter carried out by a more senior member of staff of this Public Authority.

In the event that you need to request an Internal Review, you can do so in writing to Port Director, Port Authority of the Cayman Islands, P.O. Box 1358, Grand Cayman KY1-1108, Cayman Islands or alternatively by sending an e-mail to FOI@caymanport.com. You should state that you are appealing because you are not satisfied with the initial decision and any other reasons why you feel this review is necessary.

In that event, you would normally have 30 calendar days (after the initial decision should have been sent to you) in which to make the appeal. This Public Authority will, however, allow the appeal to be made within 60 days in appropriate circumstances instead.
