Description:	<p>IALA B Port & Starboard Lateral Marks are positioned to mark the narrowest point of the channel, upon the charted 5m contour, for approach to the cargo pier in George Town.</p> <p>The marked channel at its narrowest point is approximately 0.8 cables in width.</p> <p>The Port Lateral Marker is marking a reported but uncharted coral head immediately (approx. 30ft) due West of the charted 5m contour.</p>
Action Required:	<p>Vessels requiring in excess of 5m water depth are to utilize the designated channel and exercise caution when underway upon approach or departure. Excessive maneuvering within the 20m charted contour is not recommended due to the proximity of navigational hazards.</p> <p>Other vessels are to keep clear of vessels constrained by their draught within the channel and in any circumstance abide by COLREGS.</p>
