	<ul> <li>❖ The Premier informed the BOD that he had signed a Ministerial level Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with China Harbour Engineering Company Limited (CHEC) for the development of cruise berths in George Town and redevelopment of Spotts and investment in Turtle Farm</li> <li>❖ The main agreements for the construction of the berthing facilitates at George Town will have to be negotiated but the MOU calls for a 49 years concession period</li> <li>❖ A financing structure will be developed that allows locals to invest in the project</li> <li>❖ Spotts landing will be developed as a part of this package and US\$3 million is earmarked for this</li> <li>❖ Mr. Noel March again declared his interest in Royal Construction Company</li> <li>❖ Decco's Intellectual Property (IP) information will be purchased by CHEC</li> <li>❖ The MOU was tabled and forms apart of these minutes</li> <li>❖ The member unamanioulsy agreed to now move forward with CHEC</li> </ul>
