Subject: EXEMPTION GRANTED – CURFEW

I am writing to inform you that your organisation has been deemed Essential, therefore exempt from Curfew imposed pursuant to the section 49(1) of the Police Law (2014 Revision) to specifically combat the COVID-19 pandemic threat.

This exemption grants freedom of movement for **critical staff** during the hours that a curfew has been imposed.

If stopped by law enforcement during curfew hours, the Essential Staff Member is required to comply with law enforcement instructions and to present this letter, along with a letter from you naming the staff member as essential and company issued identification.
