THE PORT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2013

The Governor in Cabinet, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Port Authority Law (1999 Revision), makes the following regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Port (Amendment) Regulations, 2013. Citation

2. The Port Regulations (2011 Revision), in these Regulations referred to as the “principal Regulations”, are amended in regulation 148(1) by inserting after the words “such vessel” the words “but where a local vessel is used for commercial purposes, the owner of the vessel shall be exempt from paying the fee so specified in respect of such vessel”. Amendment of regulation 148 of the Port Regulations (2011 Revision) - licence fees: local vessels

3. (1) Every matter or transaction commenced under the former Regulations and wholly or partly dealt with by the Director when the new Regulations come into force, is to be taken to be a matter or transaction commenced under the new Regulations and the new Regulations are to apply accordingly. Transitional provisions and reimbursement of certain fees

(2) Where, between 20th September, 2012 and the date of commencement of these Regulations, the Director received money for payment of licence fees in respect of a local vessel that is used for commercial purposes, the Director shall reimburse the person who made the payment.

(3) In this regulation -

“former Regulations” means the principal Regulations in force immediately before the date of commencement of these Regulations; and

“new Regulations” means the principal Regulations as amended by these Regulations.
